Reopening of the 5th floor of Terminal 1 as "SHIKISAI GARDEN -Seasonal colors-!"

The 5th floor of the Central Building of Terminal 1 (including the Observation Deck), which has been closed for renovation since last April, will be reopened as "SHIKISAI GARDEN -Seasonal colors-" on Thursday, April 9, 2026.

This area was designed under the theme of "Abundant water and the changing four seasons that nurture Japan's culture and spirituality." The vast area showing a water flow and changes in the four seasons enables customers to relax while feeling the atmosphere of Japan.

Narita Airport, the aerial gateway of Japan, provides a new value of "Enjoying your stay," aiming to provide more convenience and comfort to our customers.


(1) Entrance (atrium) (4F)



- **(1) Entrance (atrium) (4F)**
 - Bamboo handicraft, "Ring of Sky," by Tanabe Chikuunsai IV welcomes customers.
- **(2) Relaxation Area: "CHA-NO-MA (Tea Room)"; "I-NO-MA (Living Room)"; "SHO-NO-MA (Calligraphy Room)"**
 - The calm space with various types of seating harmonious with each room provides customers opportunities to experience Japanese-style relaxation until their departure time.
- **(3) Digital Art Area: "in sync"**
 - The art area in the motif of a bamboo grove, with light and a moving flow, calms customers passing by.
- **(4) Food Court**
 - Under the theme of "Terrace with the changing four seasons," the four columns in different colors representing the four seasons vividly brighten customers' dining space.
- **(5) Kids Area**
 - Froebel-kan Kinder Platz, a fee-charging kids park operated by Froebel-kan Co., Ltd., and other facilities provide an enjoyable time to customers with kids.
- **(6) Observation Deck: "GARDEN WALK"**
 - The Observation Deck, where customers can enjoy the surrounding greenery, the sound of a brook, footbaths, and a pleasant view from the height of the mountain deck, provides an out-of-the-ordinary experience of watching airplanes taking off and landing up close, which is only possible at an airport.
