

Items prohibited, restricted, or under storage control in security restricted areas (SRA; apron areas)

SRA prohibited items (Attachment 1)

- ◆ Bringing into the SRA: Prohibited
- ◆ Application: N/A

- ◆ These items are prohibited from being brought into the SRA.



Guns and firearms



Swords



Other lethal items

SRA restricted items (Attachment 2)

- ◆ Bringing into the SRA: Permitted
- ◆ Application: Required

- ◆ These items are permitted to be brought into the SRA on condition of NAA's approval obtained by notifying NAA of the following matters (e.g., item name, quantity, purpose of use, period of use, etc.) in prior application.
- ◆ To store these items in the SRA, **the person that has obtained approval** is required to lock the storage place and control the number of items stored periodically.
- ◆ To bring these items out of the SRA, **the person that has obtained approval** is required to confirm that the total of the number of the items to be brought out of the SRA and the number of items to be stored in the SRA equals the number of restricted items for which approval has been obtained.

Items under SRA storage control (Attachment 3)

- ◆ Bringing into the SRA: Permitted
- ◆ Application: Not required

- ◆ These items are permitted to be brought into the SRA without making prior application to NAA.
- ◆ The business entity that has brought these items into the SRA is required to lock the storage place (or install a surveillance camera if the place cannot be locked) and control the number of items before and after use.
- ◆ The business entity is responsible for strict control of the stored items (NAA is not necessarily required to check the status).
