Airport users will be able to experience Japanese culture and take souvenir photographs in this popular corner of the passenger terminal.


February will feature the very popular hands-on Ukiyo-e printing, Origami experience workshop, Kimono dress-up, Samurai armor as well as ninja outfits for children.
