Traditional Japanese Culture Experience Corner

Held every day!

Popular events are held each day on the airside after outbound passport control where airport users can experience Japanese culture and take photos of the event.

Events in July will include making origami, Ukiyo-e printing, yukata (festival wear) dress up, as well as calligraphy, Japanese paper (washi) doll making and kite making, bonseki (the art of creating miniature sand and stone landscaping in a tray), and mizuhiki accessory making.

Bonseki is being offered for the first time as a trial and provides airport customers with the opportunity to experience traditional Japanese art.


