Peach to launch a new flight operation on the Narita-Seoul (Incheon) route on September 20, 2026!

Peach Aviation Limited (IATA code: MM) will launch a new flight operation on the Narita-Seoul (Incheon) route on September 20, 2026. This will be the airline's first new international route from Narita Airport in around seven years since 2019, and will also be its second international route from that airport in addition to the Taipei route.

As the schedule of this route departs Narita in the morning and arrives in Seoul around noon, it helps passengers, especially those residing in Japan, to fully enjoy their time in Seoul, such as for sightseeing or shopping, from the very first day of their arrival.

Seongsu-dong, which has been gaining attention in Seoul in recent years, is an area spotlighted as a trend source as seen in successive openings of stores, including flagship stores for various brands and interior shops offering unique sundry goods. Additionally, Mangwon Market, vibrant with local people, is growing in popularity among tourists as well, offering a chance to savor reasonably priced Korean cuisine in a local atmosphere.
