Austrian Airlines to Resume Narita - Vienna Service from 15 May 2018

Austrian Airlines (IATA Code: OS) will resume its Narita - Vienna Service after an interval of 20 months. The airline suspended the service in September 2016 after operating the route from July 1989.

Austria has rich historical, cultural and natural attractions. Vienna is known for the capital of music, and the Austrian Alps with vast natural features and the Salzkammergut region, being famous for the movie "Sound of Music", are also very attractive places.

Austria was visited by approximately 210,000(*) visitors from Japan in 2016 and is one of Europe's most popular destinations for tourists from Japan.
