

Amendments to International Passenger Charge

Narita International Airport Corporation (NAA) will amend the International Passenger Service Facility Charge (PSFC) and Passenger Security Service Charge (PSSC) at Narita International Airport as outlined below, effective from Friday, 1 September 2023.

Since Narita Airport's opening in May 1978, NAA's top priority has been to offer a consistent level of safety and satisfaction to our valued customers, for which we have incorporated and offered various kinds of initiatives through the years. During the COVID-19 pandemic, NAA made every effort to retain its commitment to offer such customer-first service. This included providing support for flights and shops to continue operating, allowing us to fulfill our role as an international hub airport. However, with recent increases in energy prices, labor costs, and overall prices, we anticipate that it will be impossible for the company to handle these cost escalations alone. Therefore, we have no choice but to amend the aforementioned charges as listed below.

As always, NAA remains committed to ensuring safety and providing high-quality services.

1. International Passenger Service Facility Charge (PSFC) and Passenger Security Service Charge (PSSC) (including consumption tax)

* The adult charge will apply if a child is flying on an adult ticket.

* The child's charge will apply if an infant under 2 is flying on a child's ticket.

2. Commencement Date

The new charges will apply to passengers using the airport on or after 1 September 2023

* However, this applies only to tickets purchased on or after this date. Current charges will apply to tickets purchased before this date.

3. Method of collection.

As before, charges will be payable with the air fare when the ticket is purchased. (On ticket)

Note: International PSFC and PSSC are used to cover the cost of maintenance of public space and maintaining security in the passenger terminals. Except when consumption tax was increased, this is the first amendment to international PSFC on departure overseas from Terminals 1 and 2 since 1981.
