

# Japanese Hospitality "OMOTENASHI" - May Program of Events -

Tokyo, 27 April 2016: In May, we are hosting variety of events that highlight diverse Japanese culture for visitors from overseas to have an experience and to come visit Japan again.

This will include a meet and greet event by the Fuji Musume (wisteria maiden) in her beautiful kimono, an exhibition of early summer bonsai, and the traditional Japanese culture corner which has been open every day since the beginning of April.

#### Wisteria Maiden Walk-By

The Fuji Musume (wisteria maiden) is often the theme for Japanese dolls and is depicted on Japanese wooden game racket "hagoita". She will stroll around the terminals accompanied by shamisen performers.

She will also offer dance performances accompanied by Japanese melodies so that passengers can take home some cultural experience of Japan before their departure.



## **Early Summer Bonsai Exhibition**

A bonsai exhibition will be held with the cooperation of the Nippon Bonsai Association. The bonsai works on display will feature the beautiful fresh greenery of early summer.

On 21 and 22 May visitors will have a chance to learn how to take care of bonsai and to see the master hands in creating them.



#### **Iris Decoration Float Exhibition**

A boat like float decorated with irises (ayame kazari-bune) will be displayed with the cooperation of the Katori City Office, in conjunction with the Suigo Sawara Iris Festival held in Katori City in Chiba Prefecture between 28 May and 26 June.

The departure lobby will be decorated in typical Japanese scenes of the fresh, early summer.



## **Japanese Cultural Experience Corner**

Once again, departing passengers will be able to experience Japanese culture and take souvenir photographs during May in the popular corner of the passenger terminal.

The public also has the opportunity to try on Samurai armor and kimono in May.

As part of the airport's special Golden Week Holidays program, passengers who post photographs taken at the cultural experience corner on a social network system will have their photographs specially mounted by the "photo spot service".


