At the same time, the large windows offer a stunning view of arriving and departing aircraft for those seeking a sense of exhilaration before their flight. 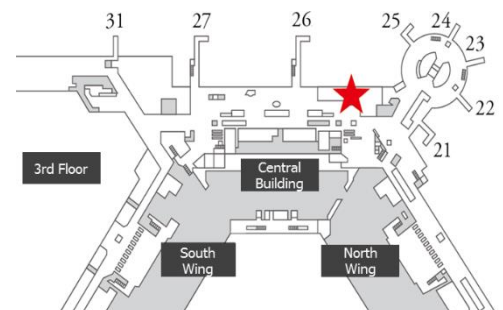
