Now Even More International Flights from Terminal 3!

Jetstar Airways (JQ) and Jeju Air (7C) moving into Terminal 3!

Tokyo, 26 February 2015: With the opening of Terminal 3 on 8 April 2015, Jetstar Japan, Vanilla Air and Spring Japan have already signified their intention to use the new terminal. Narita International Airport Corporation (NAA) is pleased to announce that two more carriers, Jetstar Airways (JQ) and Jeju Air (7C), have now also decided to move into Terminal 3.

The Australian-based low cost carrier (LCC), Jetstar Airways, currently flies from Narita to three cities in Australia: Cairns, Gold Coast and Melbourne. Jeju Air is a Korean-based LCC that currently links Narita and Seoul (Incheon).

With these two carriers, there are now 5 airline tenants in Terminal 3, adding to Narita's international networks.

The opening of Terminal 3 in April will make LCC air travel much more familiar to the public and offer greater convenience for transit passengers from overseas to every region of Japan and vice versa. We cordially invite you to take advantage of this opportunity to enjoy flying on LCCs.
