The Narita Airport –"Tokyo Disney Resort®" bus route will join the "Narita Air & Bus!" program with a big savings for all users with the introduction of special discounted bus fares. Since 2015 summer, concerted efforts have been made to promote direct bus services from Narita Airport to various tourist destinations with the "Narita Air & Bus!"

Currently, there are five routes on the program to Nikko, Niigata, Toyama & Kanazawa, Kyoto & Universal Studios Japan®, and Mt. Fuji & Fuji-Q Highland. With this new service, passengers on domestic LCC services as well as all visitors to Japan can take advantage of the direct bus services to "Tokyo Disney Resort®", one of Japan's most popular theme parks. Users can also take advantage of the special discount bus fares on Narita Airport to Shin-Urayasu area services. The bus operators and Narita International Airport Corporation will join hands to raise awareness of to encourage use.

- ✓ The 2,450 yen one-way regular bus fare will be discounted to 1,800 yen!
- ✓ Pamphlets in other than Japanese for the parks are available at the bus ticket counters.

- There are 32 services a day on the "Tokyo Disney Resort®" route (18 from Narita Airport and 14 to Narita Airport), with services operating every 30 minutes during peak periods. Buses stop at "Tokyo Disneyland® Park", "Tokyo DisneySea® Park" as well as the Disney Hotels and other official hotels for those who would like to spend the day in luxury at one of the hotels.
